Traffic and Parking Guidelines:



- 1. Gate Operations and Access
 - a. Day 1 Pre-Graduation
 - i. UPOU Gate (for vehicles coming from the National Highway) OPEN
 - ii. IRRI Gate (for vehicles passing through UPLB campus) OPEN
 - b. Day 2 Graduation
 - i. **UPOU Gate** (for vehicles coming from the National Highway) will remain **OPEN** before the event and will be **CLOSED** once the picture-taking at the Oblation Plaza begins
 - ii. IRRI Gate (for vehicles passing through UPLB campus) OPEN
 - iii. **Tabon Gate** (along National Highway) will remain **CLOSED** before the event and will **OPEN** when the UPOU Gate is closed.
- 2. Traffic and Parking Management
 - a. An **Auto Pass** has been provided to all graduates and must be displayed on the **lower left-hand portion** of their vehicle's windshield.
 - b. The **detailed traffic flow** is visually indicated in the **map**.
 - c. Upon entering the campus, drivers may **drop off** the graduates at their designated event areas and may proceed towards the **designated parking areas**. Drivers who are also graduates may proceed directly to the parking area. **Shuttle services** are available for all guests.
 - d. Guests' vehicles must be parked only in the designated parking zones (as indicated in the map), specifically:
 - i. along the UPLB Access Road (parallel)
 - ii.along the VetMed Road (parallel)
 - iii. along the Pili Drive (perpendicular)
 - iv. at the WCMPB (perpendicular)
 - v. at the Community Hub (perpendicular)
 - e. Please be advised that vehicles are parked at the owner's risk, and management cannot assume responsibility for any loss or damages.
 - f. To assist guests, especially those parked in areas farthest from the venue:
 - i. A shuttle service will operate continuously before, during and after the ceremony.
 - ii. Shuttle pick-up points will be positioned in high-volume, accessible locations and will be clearly marked on-site.
 - iii. Public safety marshals and security personnel will assit in loading/unloading and coordinating queueing to ensure orderly movement.
 - g. After the ceremony:
 - i. Shuttle services are available to ferry drivers to their parking areas. (In front of ICC, and MPH area).
 - ii. Vehicles will be released in a controlled and phased manner to avoid congestion.
 - iii. **UPOU Gate** and **IRRI Gate** will serve as the primary **exit points**.
 - iv. Public safety marshals and security personnel will guide drivers to ensure a smooth outward flow.
